

3.3 Minimum Academic Qualification for B. Arch.:-

- a. No candidate shall be admitted to architecture course unless she/he has passed an examination at the end of the 10+2 scheme of examination with Physics, Chemistry & Mathematics subjects or passed 10+3 Diploma Examination with Mathematics as compulsory subject.
- b. The candidate who have qualified the aptitude test i.e. NATA-2021 conducted by COA with pass percentage in 10+2 scheme of examination with PCM or 10+3 Diploma with Mathematics .
- c. Merit list shall be based on aggregate marks of 10+2 and valid NATA-2021 score in the ratio 50:50.
- d. In order to pass NATA Test a candidate must have valid NATA-2021 Score as per COA.

The candidate who have qualified the aptitude test i.e. NATA-2021, with pass percentage in 10+2 scheme of examination with PCM or 10+3 Diploma with Mathematics shall be eligible for admission to B. Arch Course for academic session 2021-22.

a. Basis of admission for B. Arch:

Admission shall be made on the basis of valid NATA-2021 score as declared by Council of Architecture (COA) and marks secured in the qualifying examination in the ratio of 50:50.

b. Tie breaking criteria for B. Arch:

The following under mentioned criteria will be followed to break-up the tie:

- i. Candidate getting higher marks in Mathematics shall rank higher in order of merit.
- ii. If tie still persists, candidate getting higher marks in English shall rank higher in order of merit.
- iii. If tie still persists, senior in age will rank higher in order of merit.
- iv. If tie still persists, the candidate whose name appears first in alphabetical order (in English as mentioned in qualifying examination mark sheet) shall rank higher in order of merit.
- v. If tie still persists, the Father's Name of the candidate whose name appears first in alphabetical order (in English as mentioned in qualifying examination mark sheet) shall rank higher in order of merit.
